The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has invoked the writ jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking appropriate writ of mandamus for issuance of directions to the respondents to release the interest at the rate of 18% p.a. for the delayed period of payment of retiral dues and payment of arrears of salary, with further directions to the respondents to release the illegal deductions made along with interest @ 18% p.a. as well as to decide the legal notice dated 08.06.2021 (Annexure P-6).

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with

direction to the official respondents to consider the legal notice dated 08.06.2021 (Annexure P6), as representation and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
