The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C for issuance of directions to respondents to undertake the investigation in case FIR No.369 dated 13.07.2022 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 323, 34, 447, 452, 506, 511 of IPC, registered at Police Station Kaithal, City District Kaithal in a fair, just and un-biased manner.

Considering the grievance raised by the petitioner, vide order dated 18.10.2022, the State was called upon to file the status report with regard to the proceedings of investigation conducted so far.

Learned State counsel has filed status report by way of an affidavit of Anil Kumar, HPS, DSP, (HQ), Kaithal, dated 15.12.2022, wherein para 4 reads as under:-

“That on 27.07.2022 the investigation was conducted by ASI Randeep Singh No.7/KTL. On 23.08.2022 CCTV footage of the place of occurrence S/o Rampal and Navee Chahal S/o Ajit Singh were joined in the investigation. On 20.09.2022 during

verification of Inspector Mahinder Singh the then SHO Kaithal and Ravinder Sangwan DSP it was found that Geeta's husband is brother of wife of Ashok Kumar. During investigation it was found that Sunita w/o Ashok had filed a civil suit against her brother and the allegations of taking Bullet motorcycle by Arvind s/o Ashok Kumar took Bullet Motorcycle; allegations of breaking DVR were found false. A dispute of money and land is pending between the parties. During investigation Section 452 IPC was deleted and Section 454 was added in this case. On completion of investigation Challan against Naveen Chahal, Deepak Dhull, Manju and Preeti Rani was submitted in the Court on 24.11.2022.”

As per the stand taken by the learned State counsel and after going through the status report, it is evident that investigation in the said FIR is complete and challan stands presented before the Court on 24.11.2022.

Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal the present petition with liberty to raise all the pleas taken before the Court, at an appropriate stage.

The present petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforesaid liberty.
