Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

This petition has been filed praying for quashing of the FIR No.0128 dated 31.07.2019, under Sections 341, 323, 354, 354-B, 148, 149 of IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Sangrur, District Sangrur along with subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

This Court vide order dated 25.09.2019 referred the parties for recording their statements before the learned Area Magistrate/trial Court. The report of the Magistrate is received which would show that petitioner No.1 namely, Charanjit Singh @ Charna did not appear before the Court for getting his statement recorded.

Learned State counsel has informed that there are 13 other cases against petitioner No.1, Charanjit Singh @ Charna and presently, he is behind bars. She further submits that there are two accused in this case.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that even if the petitioner No.1 is required in other cases that will not be a bar to entertain the petition.

After hearing counsel for the parties, this Court is not inclined to entertain this petition as the involvement of petitioner No.1 in a number of cases is sufficient ground to discard the prayer. The petition is however, disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to avail their remedies as available to them in accordance with the law.
