[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful disobedience of order, Annexure P-1, dated 31.05.2022, in CWP No.12324 of 2022 in case titled as '**Vijay Laxmi and another vs. State of Haryana and ors.**'

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) reveals that CWP No.12324 of 2022 was disposed of by directing the respondents to look into the representation(s) dated 20.04.2022 filed by the petitioners and pass administrative order in respect thereto in accordance with law within 30 days.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners states that the claim of the petitioners as contained in the representation(s) dated 20.04.2022 has been considered and declined vide speaking order dated 17.10.2022 passed by the Deputy Director Sports, Hisar Division, Hisar (Haryana). Learned counsel therefore states that in the circumstances, the petitioners do not press the instant petition but pray for grant of liberty to the petitioners to challenge speaking order dated 17.10.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioners as prayed for.
