The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to respondent Nos. 2 and 3 to protect life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent Nos. 4 to 9, as they have attained majority and married against the wishes of their family members.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners will be satisfied if Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar, Punjab i.e. respondent No.2 is directed to look into the representation dated 10.10.2022 (Annexure P-5), made to him by the petitioners in this regard and take appropriate action on the same.

As per averments made in the petition, both the petitioners are major. Dates of birth of both the petitioners are 17.09.2004 and 17.04.2001, respectively. Copies of Aadhar cards of both the petitioners are appended with the petition as Annexures P3 and P4, respectively. They got married on 10.10.2022 as per Marriage Certificate, Annexure P-1. Photographs of the marriage are Annexure P-2.
