Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case No.SC 258 of 2014 titled as 'State Versus Balwinder Singh @ Deny etc.'" pending in the Court of Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar, arising out of FIR No.293 dated 08.12.2013, registered under Sections 307, 427, 148 and 149 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station Beas, District Amritsar Rural.

On 16.12.2021, a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court was pleased to pass the following order:-

"Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that the petitioner was granted regular bail on 18.01.2016 and thereafter has been regularly appearing in his trial but could not appear on 14.10.2021 as he inadvertently noted a wrong date. Learned counsel further undertakes on behalf of the petitioner to appear before the Trial Court on each and every date of hearing in future, unless specifically exempted.

the respondent.

Adjourned to 25.04.2022.

*Subject to his appearance before the Trial Court within ten days,
the petitioner shall be admitted to ad interim bail to the Trial Court's
satisfaction.*

However, nothing stated above shall be construed as a final expression of opinion on the merits of the case and the trial would proceed independently of the observations made in the present case which are only for the purpose of adjudicating the present bail application
