The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C praying for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.177 dated 4.6.2021 registered under Sections 363, 366 IPC at Police Station, Sadar Narwana, District Jind.

Learned State counsel, at the outset, submits that out of total 17 prosecution witnesses, 14 have already been examined by the learned Trial Court and the next date for examining rest of the witnesses is 1.7.2022.
