This is an application for seeking permission to convert the proceedings of this appeal to the proceedings under Section 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955.

Since the parties have settled their disputed by way of mutual settlement, application is allowed and the main appeal is converted under Section 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955.

Application is allowed and the statutory period of 6 months under Section 13-B(2) of the Hindu Marriage Act is waived off.

CM-10645-CII-2022

Application is allowed and the petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 for dissolution of marriage by grant of decree

of divorce by mutual consent is taken on record.

FAO-M-121-2017 (O&M)

The appellant has come up in appeal against the order and decree dated 07.01.2017 whereby petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 for dissolution of marriage by a decree of divorce has been dismissed.

Parties are present in Court today and they have made their respective statements which are taken on record. As per the statement of the appellant, she states that she has settled the matter mutually and will never claim maintenance from the respondent after getting decree of divorce. She is ready to give divorce to the respondent without any undue pressure and influence. The respondent has also made a statement to this effect.

Keeping in view the statements made by both the parties, who are physically present to attend the Court proceedings today and are being represented through their counsels, appeal is allowed and the order and decree dated 07.01.2017 is set aside. The marriage between the parties is hereby dissolved by way of mutual consent. Decree-sheet be drawn accordingly.
