In compliance of order dated 04.11.2022, the State has filed its reply by way of short affidavit of SI Manmeet Pal Singh, SHO, Police Station Majitha, Amritsar (Rural). It is deposed in the said affidavit that upon enquiries, it transpired that daughter of the petitioner, namely, Simarjit Kaur had solemnized marriage with respondent No.4 – Sandeep Singh against the consent and wishes of her parents. It is further deposed that pursuant to solemnization of marriage, they moved an application seeking protection of their lives and liberty in the Court of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar, wherein certain directions were issued as regards their threat perception.

In view of the aforestated position, it cannot be said that the daughter of the petitioner has been illegally detained.

Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that she may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition.

In view of the aforesaid submission, the petition is dismissed
as withdrawn.
