This PIL has been filed by the petitioner praying for a direction to the respondent-authorities to convert the land of *chappar / pond* existing within the area of Village Naya Gaon into a public park and not use it as a dumping ground. The respondent No.3-Municipal Council has filed an additional affidavit dated 09.11.2020, wherein in paragraphs 3 & 4 they have stated that they are proposing to construct a Community Centre-cum-Park in the area concerned for which Rs.1.41 crores has been sanctioned by the department of Local Government, Punjab (respondent No.2) and a foundation stone has also been laid.

In view of the aforesaid statement made on affidavit by the Municipal Council, Naya Gaon, nothing further survives for adjudication in the petition which is accordingly disposed of in terms of the statement made by the respondent(s) in the additional affidavit.

The petitioners would be at liberty to approach the authorities for any further relief, if so advised.
