GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioners have approached this Court seeking quashing of DDR/GD No.49 dated 04.10.2021 under Sections 341/323/506/34 IPC in FIR No.0207 dated 04.10.2021 registered at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur, under Sections 452/323/506/34 IPC and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.
2. Vide order dated 21.12.2021, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.
3. Report of learned sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Dhuri, has been received, wherein it has been reported that the joint statement of accused/petitioners, namely, Malkeet Kaur, Misra Singh, Harpreet Singh and Mukand Kaur as also the statement of complainant Sandeep Singh,

have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves.

4. The complainant Sandeep Singh in his respective statement has stated that he has no objection in case the FIR in question is quashed.
5. The learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Dhuri has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise without there being any kind of influence or coercion.
6. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and DDR/GD No.49 dated 04.10.2021 under Sections 341/323/506/34 IPC in FIR No.0207 dated 04.10.2021 registered at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur, under Sections 452/323/506/34 IPC and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
