Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to grant the subsistence allowance to the petitioner.

At the outset, learned Counsel on instructions from the petitioner submits that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case the Legal Notice dated 10.05.2021 (P-8) is considered and decided expeditiously.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Maloo Chahal, DAG, Punjab, who is present through Video-Conference, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent(s) and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.3-District Education Officer, Jalandhar to consider and decide the aforesaid Legal Notice dated 10.05.2021 (P-8) in accordance with law by passing speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
