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**AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):**

This second petition is filed seeking directions to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of private respondents (arrayed in the petition).

The earlier petition was dismissed as withdrawn by passing the following order:

*“This petition is filed seeking directions to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents (arrayed in the petition), who have solemnised marriage against the wishes of their parents.*

*After arguing for some time and realising that the petition was drafted even without waiting for the representation to reach the concerned quarter, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to pursue the representation.*

*Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.*

*However, there is no doubt that on representation reaching the concerned quarter, the same would be considered expeditiously in accordance with law.”*

After arguing for some time and realising that this is the second petition is filed without pursuing the representation, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
