JAISHREE THAKUR, J. (Oral)

This is a petition that has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking to quash FIR No.101 dated 20.04.2019, registered under Sections 420, 120-B of Indian Penal Code (Sections 467 and 468 of IPC added later on) at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur and all the subsequent proceedings arising out of the FIR, on the basis of compromise dated 19.09.2019 arrived at between the parties.

Counsel for the petitioners herein would fairly pray for some time to adhere to the terms of the compromise arrived at between the parties whereas, counsel for complainant-respondent No.2 would submit that terms of the compromise entered into as far back as September 2019 have not

been adhered to. It is submitted that the cheque that was given towards the part payment of the settlement amount has been bounced.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and found no ground to quash the FIR based on compromise, which has not been given effect to.

Accordingly, the instant petition is hereby dismissed.
