The present appeal has been filed against the judgment and decree dated 31.08.2017 passed by the Additional District Judge, Sangrur, whereby the petition filed by the respondent under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 for dissolution of marriage, has been allowed.

Learned counsel for the appellant, upon instructions, submits that his client is suffering from depression and is unable to make payment of arrears of maintenance @ Rs.4000/- per month to the respondent-wife and children pending since 2016 and in future also he

cannot clear the arrears of maintenance. On this ground alone, the present appeal deserves to be dismissed.
