This criminal writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of an appropriate writ, order or directions to official respondents, especially, in the nature of *mandamus* to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that let this petition be disposed off with a direction to respondent No.2- Commissioner of Police, Panchkula to consider and decide the representation dated 12.10.2022 (Annexure P-2) alleged to have been submitted by the petitioner seeking protection for her life and liberty along with his family members.

Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the claim of the petitioner and even the assertions set out in the petition, the present petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent No.2 that if any such representation, as indicated above, is indeed pending consideration, it shall be dealt with expeditiously in accordance with law by passing a speaking

order, preferably within four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and conveying the same to the petitioner.

The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
