The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of appropriate directions to the State to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners to which they apprehend danger due to disputes between them and the private respondents.

At the outset, learned State counsel has produced a compromise dated 27.02.2022, signed by three of the petitioners as also the private respondents, as per which all the disputes between them have been amicably resolved.

After taking the afore settlement deed on record, this Court is of the opinion that at this stage, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition.
