By way of present petition filed under Section 482 of the Code of the Criminal Procedure, 1973, petitioner seeks issuance of direction to official respondents No.1 to 3 to take action on complaints dated 04.08.2022 and 09.09.2022, Annexures P-5 and P-7, respectively, submitted to respondent No.2.

Perusal of the paper-book shows that the petitioner has alleged that on 11.07.2022, when she alongwith her sister, Tara Rani, went to her paternal home for collecting medicines and clothes of her mother, which had been left behind, they were physically assaulted by respondents No.4 to 10, who inflicted injuries on them. Photographs, Annexures P-1 and P-2, as well as Medical Examination Report, Annexure P-3, have been appended with the petition to support the allegation. It has been submitted that despite complaints, Annexures P-5 and P-7, no action has been taken.

Having considered the prayer made, petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, District SAS Nagar, Mohali - respondent No.2 to examine the complaints, Annexures P-5 and P-7, and to take suitable action thereon, as warranted in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible.
