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**VIKAS BAHL. J. (ORAL)**

This is a petition filed under Section 482 CrPC for seeking quashing of the impugned orders dated 26.03.2019 (Annexure P-7) and 03.09.2022 (Annexure P-13). In the alternate, prayer has been made for directing the learned trial Court to decide the application dated 28.03.2022 filed by the petitioner seeking permanent release of his passport and permit him to travel abroad within a fixed timeframe.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Munish Sharma, AAG Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent Nos.1 and 2 and Ms. Amrita Nagpal, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.3.

During the course of hearing, counsel for the petitioner as well as counsel for respondent No.3 have jointly stated that application dated 28.03.2022 (Annexure P-11) for seeking direction for permanent release of the passport of the

petitioner and to permit him to travel abroad is pending final adjudication and the same is listed for 15.10.2022 and that the application for cancellation of bail i.e. IA No.3 of 2022 is also listed for tomorrow and both the said application have been ordered to be heard together.

Both the counsels have jointly prayed that the application dated 28.03.2022 as well as application for cancellation of bail be decided as expeditiously as possible.

It has been jointly submitted by counsels appearing for the parties that before the trial Court, the parties would not seek any adjournment and would fully assist the Court in expeditious disposal of the said two applications. It is submitted that the pleadings in both the said applications are complete.

In the said circumstances the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to consider and adjudicate the application dated 28.03.2022 (Annexure P-11) as well as application for cancellation of bail as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of 10 days from 15.10.2022. The counsel for all the parties concerned are directed to fully assist the trial Court in expeditious disposal of both the said cases.

It is made clear that this Court has not given any opinion on the merits of the case. The application be decided in accordance with law on its own merits.
