In the present petition, the grievance being raised by the petitioners is that Sh. Balwant Singh, father of petitioners No.1 and 2 and son of petitioner No.3, died on 10.10.2016, while discharging duties in the Indo-Tibetan Border Police. Petitioners submit that though they are entitled to receive the benefits in respect of the services rendered by the Lt. father of petitioners No.1 and 2 (and son of petitioner No.3) but no benefit has been released to them so far. From the pleading, it transpires that for redressal of the same grievance, a representation dated 18.08.2021 (Annexure P-4) has already been filed by them with respondents No.2 and 3, which is still stated to be pending consideration with the authorities concerned.

Without going into merits of the present petition or the claim of the petitioners as being raised in the present petition or in the said representation dated 18.08.2021 (Annexure P-4), the interest of justice will be achieved in case respondent No.2 is directed to decide the said

representation dated 18.08.2021(Annexure P-4), filed by the petitioners, by passing an appropriate speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of the copy of this order.

It is made clear that all the concerned parties who are likely to be affected by the outcome of the decision to be passed on the said representation dated 18.08.2021 (Annexure P-4) shall be heard before passing of order on the said representation.
