AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the State, in compliance with the order dated 03.02.2022, submits that the status report by way of affidavit dated 23.02.2022 of the Block Development and Panchayat Officer, Kaithal, has been filed in Court, where in paras 2 to 4, it has been stated as follows:-

- “2. *That in compliance of the above stated order Deputy Collector, Kaithal Respondent No. 1 vide letter no. 606 dated 03-02-22 had directed the Block Development & Panchayat Officer, Kaithal for taking necessary action and for removing and taking possession of the land which is in illegal possession of the encroachers.*
3. *That it pertinent to mention here that answering respondent on dated 14-02-2022, by following due process of law, had removed illegal encroachment over the street of gram Panchayat Khanoda and vide letter No.383 dated 17-02-22 submitted a detailed possession taking report (Annexure R-1) to the Deputy Commissioner Kaithal.*
4. *That it is submitted that as illegal encroachment over the street had been removed, interim order dated 03.02.2022 passed by this Hon'ble Court has*

been duly complied off.”

In the light of the above, counsel for the State submits that the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

Counsel for the petitioner states that in case the averments made in the status report are found to be incorrect, liberty may be granted to the petitioner to move appropriate application in this regard.

In the light of the above, the writ petition is disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.
