Learned counsel for the petitioner has invoked Section 482 CrPC seeking quashing of the FIR No. 71 dated 26.06.2014 under Sections 325/323/34 IPC registered at Police Station Sujampur, District Pathankot (Annexure P1) with all subsequent proceedings on the basis of compromise entered into between the parties, as affirmed vide affidavit dated 30.07.2014 (Annexure P2).

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Ram Bhajan submits that untraced report has also been filed in the said FIR and therefore, this petition does not survive.

Taking into consideration the totality of the circumstances and the factum of compromise along with the fact that untraced report has also been filed by the police, this Court is of the considered view that no fruitful purpose would be served by keeping this petition pending or referring the parties for recording of statements.

Accordingly, this petition is disposed of as having become infructuous.
