1. Learned State counsel on instructions from respondent No.6 states that respondent No.6 has written to all the Deputy Commissioners in the State of Punjab, vide letter Annexure P/6 dated 06.10.2022, requiring compliance with the Punjab Food Grains Labour and Cartage Transportation Policy, 2022, which specifically deals with the right of tractor-trolleys having commercial licences only to transport food grains.

2. Statement of the learned State counsel is taken on record. The same satisfies learned counsel for the petitioners, who states that in the circumstances, the petitioners do not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

3. Accordingly, in view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the parties, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
