The petitioners herein have sought the relief of anticipatory bail in the criminal case arising out of the FIR bearing No.119 dated 24.11.2021 registered at Police Station City Balachaur, District Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar, under Sections 323, 341 IPC, wherein the offence under Section 295-A IPC is stated to have been added later-on.

Learned State counsel, on the instructions from ASI Bashwinder Kumar from the above-said Police Station, apprises the Court that in compliance of the order dated 14.12.2021 as passed by this Court,

the petitioners have joined in the investigation and their custodial interrogation is not required and they are also not involved in any other criminal case.

In view of the above-discussed submission as made by learned State counsel, the instant petition is allowed and the relief of interim bail, as extended to the petitioners vide the said order dated 14.12.2021, is hereby made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall continue to join in the investigation as and when required/called upon to do so and shall also strictly abide by all the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
