The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction, especially in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to frame criteria/instructions/guidelines for conducting trials for selection of the candidates for the respective events of the Youth and Heritage Festivals in the Panjab University Chandigarh.

It is submitted by counsel for the respondents-University that the necessary guidelines, as prayed in the writ petition, have already been framed by the University. Counsel has referred to a copy of the guidelines as Annexure R-3. In subsequent events, the petitioner herself had also participated in the events of the Zonal Youth and Heritage Festival. Hence, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner. Therefore, it has to be assumed that there is no objection to the proposition as disclosed by counsel for the respondents-University.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
