[1] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of order dated 28.11.2022 rejecting the representation filed by the petitioner pursuant to liberty granted vide order, Annexure P/1 dated 07.09.2022 in CWP No.20148 of 2022, he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 28.11.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.
