Present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.205, dated 02.07.2022, registered for offence punishable under Sections 307, 148 and 149 of IPC and Sections 27, 54 and 59 of Arms Act, at Police Station Chappar, District Yamunanagar.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody since 02.07.2022.

3. After the incident, the matter now stands settled and refers to the affidavit dated 14.09.2022 (Annexure P-2) executed by the petitioner as well as the victim, whereby they have admitted the fact of their being a compromise. He thus submits that trial is unlikely to result in conviction, the investigation already stands concluded and the challan has been presented.

4. Learned counsel for the complainant does not dispute the fact of their being compromise between the parties.

5. Without commenting on the merits of the case and compromise. In view of the incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

6. Needless to say nothing recorded herein shall be construed to be an expression of an opinion on the merits of the case.
