This is a second petition that has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0242, dated 12.11.2021, registered under Sections 323, 341, 336, 506, 511, 34 of IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station City Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur, Punjab.

By an order dated 16.12.2021, this Court had granted interim bail to the petitioner and directed him to join investigation.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent-State, on instructions from ASI Bhajan Lal, submits that petitioner has joined investigation and the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required at this stage. He also submits that moreover, the abovesaid FIR stands quashed on the basis of compromise arrived at between the parties in CRM-M No.387 of 2022 on 25.04.2022.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required and abovesaid FIR stands quashed, no further orders are called for, the instant petition is allowed and the order dated 16.12.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
