This petition was filed seeking directions to respondents No.3 and 4 i.e. Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana and SHO, Police Station Division No.3 for detailed investigation and looking into the complaint dated 4th September, 2019 filed by petitioner No.1 and registering the FIR and taking strict action against the respondents No. 5 to 8 (arrayed in the petition).

Learned State counsel relies upon the pleadings of the reply dated 4th February, 2020 and submits that the complaint was considered, the allegations were found false. The statement of the child in question was recorded and he wanted to live with his natural parents.
