This is a petition that has been filed under Articles 226 & 227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari, mandamus or any other writ directing respondents No.2 & 3 to allot paddy to the petitioner-Rice Mill for custom milling of rice forthwith as the petitioner is competent for allotment of paddy in view of Custom Milling Policy dated 29.09.2022 for KMS 2022-23.

Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner would contend that CWP No.15423 of 2021 that had been filed was allowed by this Court vide judgment dated 05.08.2022 and there was a direction issued to the respondents to conduct a fresh physical verification of the premises of the petitioner/firm and lift the custom milled rice, if found as per specifications. The said judgment stands challenged in LPA No.852 of 2022, however, as on date, there is no stay on the effect and operation of the orders passed in the

writ petition. The petitioner herein is entitled to allocation of paddy available for milling, however, its online application form is not being considered for allocation of paddy.

Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner herein would contend that the petitioner herein would be satisfied at the present moment in case a direction is issued for the case of the petitioner to be considered expeditiously considering the fact that the milling season is already underway.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Kirti Singh, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the paper book.

In view of the fact that the representations of the petitioner are already pending consideration, let appropriate orders be passed thereon by passing a speaking order within a period of one week from today and after giving an opportunity of personal hearing to the petitioner.

The petitioner herein is directed to present himself before respondent No.3 on 19.10.2022 at 11.00 AM.

Present petition stands disposed of on the above terms.
