ARUN MONGA, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for respondent No.2-Commission submits that petitioner does not fall in the revised waiting list as he is lower in merit from the last selected candidate of the revised waiting list who scored 59.4867 marks whereas petitioner has scored 58.6883 marks, as is borne out from the reply already filed by the Commission.

Result of the petitioner, who has concededly scored less than 59.4867 marks, is not under challenge in the instant petition. It seems that petitioner was under the wrong impression at the time of filing the instant petition that based on his performance, he would qualify.

Being not so, no grounds are made out to interfere. Dismissed.
