1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 16.10.2018, in CWP-26633-2018.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 16.10.2018, reveals that CWP-26633-2018, was disposed of by directing respondent Nos.2 and 4 to consider the case of the petitioner keeping in view the report of the expert committee and to decide his claim for promotion to the post of Professor Stage-6 under the Career Advancement Scheme immediately keeping in view the fact that the petitioner was to retire on 31.10.2018.

3. Reply has been filed by learned counsel for respondent Nos.2 and 4. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in view of the claim of the petitioner having been accepted and benefits as per entitlement having been released to the petitioner, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to

withdraw the same.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
