Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.106 dated 19.11.2021 for offence punishable under Sections 22 and 29 of NDPS Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Jhunir, District Mansa.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 16.12.2021 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Balbir Singh submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 16.12.2021 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 16.12.2021 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
