The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking indulgence of this Court to quash the action of respondent No. 6 in not allowing the petitioners to continue with their licence of Pharmacist and to allow the continuation renewal in view of Section 32 of the Pharmacy Act, 1948.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners contend that he has already submitted a representation Annexure P-17 to the respondent-authorities and submitted that he would be satisfied at this juncture in case the present petition is disposed of in terms of the order dated 04.04.2022 passed in *CWP No. 6339 of 2022 titled as Vineet Kumar and others versus State of Haryana and others.*

Learned Advocate General has no objection if the abovesaid prayer is accepted. Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with the consent of the parties without commenting on the merits of the case in terms of the order dated 04.04.2022 passed in ***CWP No. 6339 of 2022 titled as Vineet Kumar and others versus State of Haryana and others.***

The petitioners undertakes to appear before the Registrar-Haryana State Pharmacy Council for representing the case on 16.12.2022 at 11:00 A.M., who shall dispose of the representation Annexure P-17 after affording proper opportunity to the respective parties.
