Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that the petitioners are working on part time basis for the last 19 years and they were entitled to be considered for regularization keeping in view the Policy of the Govt. dated 11.11.2003 (Annexure P-1) but the said benefit has not been granted to the petitioner though, as per the settled principle of law, petitioners are entitled for regularization of their services.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

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Learned counsel for the respondents submits that as per his instructions, the petitioners have not raised the grievance as raised in the present petition before the competent authorities so far and in case, any grievance is raised by the petitioners, the same will be considered in accordance with law and appropriate order will be passed within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of any such representation.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in view of the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioners to approach the competent authority for the grievance as raised in the present petition.
