At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners has pointed out that the present revision petition was filed against the order dated 09.08.2021 passed by Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Faridabad, whereby interim maintenance was granted to the petitioners and they are seeking modification thereof, as the interim maintenance awarded to them, is on the lower side. However, during the pendency of the present petition before this Court, the proceedings before the trial Court under Section 125 Cr.P.C. have proceeded, the evidence has almost been recorded and the trial is at fag end.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners states that he will be satisfied in case the trial Court is directed to decide the application under Section 125 Cr.P.C. finally within a time bound manner.

3. Mr. Gupta, learned counsel for the respondent is not averse to the said proposal.

4. With the consent of both the parties, the trial Court is thus directed to decide the proceedings under Section 125 Cr.P.C. within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

5. Mr. Gupta, Advocate for the respondent has also fairly undertaken that during the said period, the respondent namely Sunil Kumar Sharma shall keep on paying for the educational expenses of the children without fail.

6. Ordered accordingly.

7. The present revision petition is disposed off.

8. Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed off.
