This is a petition that has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent authorities to refix the seniority/merit list of the petitioner by considering the marks obtained in papers which were cleared in supplementary examination of Lower School Course and to promote him to the post of Sub-Inspector and release all the consequential benefits.

At the very outset, counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner would submit that in this regard, the petitioner has filed a representation dated 16.08.2022 (Annexure P-7) before the respondents, but till date no decision has been taken thereon. He would submit that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied in case his said representation is decided, in accordance with law, in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Kirti Singh, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that the respondents will look into the matter and will take a decision on the representation of the petitioner.

Let sufficient number of copies of the complete paper book be supplied to her during the course of day.

Without commenting on merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide representation dated 16.08.2022 (Annexure P-7) of the petitioner within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law and convey the decision to the petitioner. In case of failure to do so, the officer responsible for the lapse would be liable to costs of Rs.20,000/- from his personal pocket, to be deposited with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Advocates Welfare Fund.
