The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.11 dated 29.01.2021 registered under Sections 420, 379, 427, 447, 511, 120-B IPC (Sections 467, 468, 471 IPC added later) at Police Station Dhariwal, District Gurdaspur.

The operative part of the order dated 20.12.2021, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioner, is reproduced as under:-

“....Counsel for the petitioner has relied upon the proceedings dated 23.11.2021 before the Mediator of this Court, vide which some settlement is arrived at between the co-accused Jagroop and John William, who are ready to pay Rs.15.00 lacs to the complainant as full and final settlement and have also paid some amount. It is further submitted that noticing the said fact both the aforesaid co-

*accused have been granted the concession of interim bail.
Notice of motion.... ”*

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 20.12.2021, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Counsel for the State assisted by counsel for the complainant and on instructions from ASI Ranjit Singh, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 20.12.2021 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
