ARUN PALLI, J. (Oral):

Vide this petition under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. the petitioners pray for anticipatory bail in FIR No.132 dated 16.08.2020, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 452 and 506 of IPC, registered at Police Station Lalru, District SAS Nagar, Mohali.

Upon hearing the learned counsel for the petitioners on 15.12.2021, this Court had enlarged the petitioners on interim bail:-

“The petitioners have approached this Court seeking grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered vide FIR No.0132 dated 16.8.2020 at Police Station Lalru, District SAS Nagar, Mohali, Punjab under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 452 and 506 of Indian Penal Code.

The FIR in question was lodged by Jagtar Singh, son-in-law of petitioners No.1 and 2, wherein allegations have been levelled to the effect that he was beaten up by the petitioners i.e. by his father-in-law, mother-in-law, brothers-in-law and other relatives. It has been submitted that, even if, the allegations as levelled in the FIR are taken to be correct, it is a case of inflicting simple injuries only.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioners be released on interim bail subject to their furnishing personal bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer.

However, the petitioners shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Arresting/Investigating Officer and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel submits that pursuant to the order dated 15.12.2021 (ibid) the petitioners had joined the investigation and are no longer required for any custodial interrogation.

In the wake of the above, the order dated 15.12.2021, is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition is accordingly disposed of.
