The petitioners seek grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.320 dated 19.11.2021 registered under Section 306 IPC 1860 at Police Station B Division, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 16.12.2021, petitioners have joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Parminder Singh admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 16.12.2021 is made absolute. However, the petitioners shall keep on

joining the investigation as and when required to do so and they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
