Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C seeking quashing of FIR No.16 dated 06.02.2021 registered under Sections 406, 498-A of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Women Police Station, Jalandhar City, District Jalandhar (Annexure P-5) and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, including the challan (Annexure P-7), which has been presented.

Vide order dated 02.02.2022, private parties were referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, where the dispute has been settled. By referring to Clause 7(ii) of settlement/agreement dated

27.04.2022, counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have paid a sum of Rs.50,000/- in cash to the complainant/respondent No.2 and requests that demand draft deposited by them with the Registrar General of this Court in pursuance to the interim order dated 20.12.2021, may be returned to them.

Counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.2 does not have any objection.

In view of the above, demand draft bearing No.386797 dated 24.12.2021 deposited with the Registrar General of this Court, validity of which, has expired by now, is ordered to be handed back to the petitioners/their counsel.

In view of the settlement, counsel for the petitioners seeks and is granted permission to withdraw the petition with liberty to institute a fresh petition seeking quashing of the FIR on the basis of compromise.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
