By this petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of 'mandamus' directing the respondents to issue a formal provisional allotment letter and deliver physical possession of the school site in the Urban Estate, Gurugram, in pursuance of recommendations made by a selection committee (copy Annexure P-5), and a subsequent *ex post facto* allotment/ recommendation made by respondent no.2/Chief Administrator, vide a letter dated 24.09.1993 (copy Annexure P-6).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in respect of its grievance the petitioner trust had got issued a legal notice on 16.08.2021 (copy Annexure P-21) to the respondents, which has still not been decided and consequently this petition may actually be disposed of with a direction to the competent authority amongst the respondents to take a decision on the aforesaid legal notice by passing a speaking order within a specified time frame.

That being so, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority amongst the respondents to hear the petitioner and all concerned and to pass a speaking order in response to the legal notice Annexure P-21, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

It is to be noticed that upon specific query, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that even if any order has been passed, no such order has been ever conveyed to the petitioner.
