Instant petition had been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for seeking appropriate directions to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to arrest respondent No.4-accused in the FIR No.0057 dated 24.03.2021 under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Dehlon, Ludhiana.

Mr. Karanbir Singh, AAG Punjab on instruction from ASI Karamjit Singh has placed on record the status report by way of affidavit of Deep Kamal, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police (South), Ludhiana, as per which it is stated that matter has already been investigated into and the signatures of respondent No.4 are not found to have been appended on the sale agreement relied upon by the petitioner. It is contended that the Joint Commissioner of Police-City and Traffic has conducted the enquiry and recommended to cancel the

FIR and accordingly a cancellation report under Section 173 CrPC has been prepared.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the instant case with liberty to take recourse to alternative remedies and to raise appropriate challenge to the investigation so conducted by the investigating agency.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
