SURESHWAR THAKUR, J. (ORAL)

1. The learned State counsel submits, that during the course of investigations being underway in the present FIR, the petitioner has been arrested in FIR No.281 of 28.11.2021. Therefore, for the afore reason, the instant petition becomes rendered infructuous.

2. However, if the bail petitioner is released from custody in FIR No.281 of 28.11.2021, thereupon, the investigating officer concerned, may not arrest the bail petitioner in respect of the instant FIR, unless 7 days' notice becomes served upon him.

3. Liberty is also reserved to the petitioner to re-access this Court, at an appropriate stage.
