This is an application to place on record asserts and personal details of petitioner by way of affidavit as Annexure P-4.

In view of the contents and prayer clause of the application, the same is allowed. Annexure P-4 is taken on record.

CRM-M-52983-2021

Vide order dated 20.01.2022, this Court had granted interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 20.01.2022 the petitioner has joined the investigation.

3. This fact has not been disputed by the learned State counsel on instructions received from HC Malkeet Singh. However, learned State

counsel has opposed the bail. He further submits that in case this Court is inclined to give the bail to the petitioner then it should be subject to the strict and stringent conditions.

4. Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the bail application on the ground that the pleadings are false and incorrect.
5. This Court is concerned only with pre-trial incarceration as well as custodial incarceration at this stage. The petitioner is a woman, hence entitled to lenient provision of Cr.P.C. Without commenting on the case's merits and the circumstances peculiar to this case, the petitioner makes a case for release on bail.
6. Given above, the present petition is allowed. The order dated 20.01.2022, is hereby made absolute.
