[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1, dated 05.04.2022 in CWP No.1342 of 2022 in case titled as P.C. Gupta vs. UCO Bank and others.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.1342 of 2022 was disposed of by directing respondent No.2 therein to pass appropriate speaking order on legal notice dated 15.04.2022 filed by the petitioner within eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order and in case, the petitioner was found entitled to any benefit, to release the same to the petitioner within four weeks thereafter.

[3] Learned Counsel for respondent No.2 has filed compliance report-cum-reply by way of affidavit dated 10.12.2022. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner who on perusal thereof states that in view of respondent No.2 having

agreed to consider the claim of the petitioner, he does not press the instant petition and would submit the relevant claim documents for processing his claim in accordance with law.

[4] Learned counsel for respondent No.2 states that in the eventuality of the relevant claim documents being submitted to respondent No.2, the same would be considered as per law and benefits, if any, found as per entitlement would be released to the petitioner within two months from the receipt of the claim documents.

[5] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the parties, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner to submit relevant claim documents to respondent No.2 and on needful being done within four weeks from today, the same be considered and processed as per law within two months of receipt and payment, if any found due, be released to the petitioner within one month thereafter.
