[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1, dated 11.07.2022 in CRM-M No.775 of 2021 in case titled as Deepak Kumar vs. State of Haryana and others.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CRM-M No.775 of 2021 was disposed of by directing the Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra, District Kurukshetra to decide the representations /applications dated 12.11.2020, 08.12.2020 and 09.12.2020 by passing a speaking order within 30 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the aforementioned representations /applications having been decided by the respondent vide order dated 05.08.2022, the petitioner does not wish to pursue the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to challenge order dated 05.08.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instantpetition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
