GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioners have approached this Court seeking grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered vide FIR No.660 dated 03.10.2021 at Police Station City Narnaul, District Mahendergarh, under Sections 148/149/387/365 IPC and Section 25/29 of the Arms Act.
2. At the time of issuance of notice of motion on 20.12.2021, the following order was passed:

“Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that they have falsely been implicated in the instant case and that Ajit Yadav is not named in the FIR and is later sought to be involved on the premises that he is also known by the name Amit @ Monu. Learned counsel has submitted that in any case, the petitioners have clear antecedents and are not involved in any other case and that an identically situated co-accused has already been granted bail by this Court vide order dated 2.12.2021 passed in CRM-M-49046-2021 (Annexure P-2).

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioners be released on interim bail subject to their furnishing personal bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Arresting/Investigating Officer and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

3. Learned State counsel upon instructions has informed that pursuant to interim directions issued by this Court, the petitioners have since joined investigation and are not required for any custodial interrogation and that they are not involved in any other case.
4. Having regard to the aforestated position, wherein the petitioners are stated to have joined investigation and are not required for any custodial interrogation and are not stated to be involved in any other case, the petition is accepted and the interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 20.12.2021 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
