Mr. Ankit Kharbanda, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.2/complainant and filed power of attorney, which is taken on record.

On 17.12.2021, the following order was passed:-

"Petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No. 84 dated 26.10.2021 under Sections 323/406/498-A of IPC of 1860, registered at Police Station Women Cell, Amritsar.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that marriage was solemnized on 11.10.2020, the complainant remained in the matrimonial house for a brief period of 3 to 4 months only and voluntarily left for the parental house. The parents of the petitioner have been granted pre-arrest bail. The car, air conditioner and some jewellery has already been recovered during the period when parents of the petitioner were on interim bail.

Ms. Ruchika Sabherwal, AAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing

personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in pursuance of interim directions issued by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

On instructions from ASI Kuldeep Singh, learned State counsel has not assailed the aforesaid factual aspects and states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the aforesaid submissions, the order dated 17.12.2021, granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition is allowed.
