TRIBHUVAN DAHIYA, J. (ORAL)

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to approach the Executing Court by moving an appropriate application to make payment of decretal amount in installments.

Leave is granted.

The present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner/judgment debtor to approach the Executing Court by moving an application for making payment of the decretal amount along with interest in installments, within a period of one week from today, i.e., upto 25.10.2022, which shall be considered by the Court on its merits.

Till filing of the application, arrest of the petitioner shall remain stayed.

In case, the application is not filed upto 25.10.2022, this petition shall be deemed to have been dismissed and the order of stay shall also stand vacated.

Deposit of the decreetal amount by the petitioner will be without prejudice to his rights in the pending appeal before the Delhi High Court.
